COUNCIL TO APPROVE HIRING ONE FULL-TIME AND ONE PART-TIME POLICE

OFFICER WITH THE BOROUGH OF UNION CITY: President Brumagin said the purpose of this meeting is to approve hiring one full-time and one part-time police officer with the Borough of Union City.

Councillor Bowes said that he, the Mayor, President Brumagin and Chief Jones met with the candidates.

He said after interviewing the candidates the committee all agreed that George Barber should be hired as the full-time officer to serve as the Resource Officer at the school and David Pernice to be hired as the part-time police officer.

MOTION TO APPROVE HIRING GEROGE BARBER AS THE FULL-TIME POLICE

OFFICER AND DAVID PERNICE AS THE PART-TIME POLICE OFFICER: It was moved by Councillor Bowes and seconded by Councillor Steadman

to hire George Barber as the full-time police officer to serve as the Resource Officer at the school and David Pernice to be hired as the part-time police officer. Motion carried.
