

**MINUTES**  
**UNION CITY BOROUGH COUNCIL**  
**WORK SESSION**  
**AUGUST 25<sup>TH</sup>, 2009**

The Work Session of the Union City Borough Council was called to order at 7:09 P.M. by President Brumagin. The meeting was held at the City Building, 13 South Main Street.

Councillors present were Brumagin, Bowes, Hinkle and Steadman. Councillor Hoban and Tubbs were absent.

Officials present were Borough Manager Cheryl Capela, Mayor Paul Capela and Police Chief Kevin Jones.

Visitors present were Steve Sears.

**RESOURCE OFFICER:** Councillor Bowes said he feels that George Barber will make a very good Resource Officer. He said that he was very impressed with him. He said that George has worked with Family Services and he also was a music teacher before he became a police officer.

He said he knows the school has not had a chance to meet with George. He said he would like Chief Jones to make arrangements with School Superintendent Sam Myers and any school board member who would like to meet with George.

**PARKS AND RECREATION:** Councillor Bowes said he would like to know if Jim Ingall has submitted his letter of resignation from the Parks and Recreation Commission.

The Borough Manager said that she has spoke with Jim and he informed

her that he is resigning from the commission. She said that she informed him that he would need to send her his letter resigning from the commission. She said that she still has not received his resignation letter.

Councillor Bowes said that Jim has not attended any Parks and Recreation meetings for the past several months.

He said according to the by-laws, the commission can remove him from the board.

He said the commission members would like to replace him with Michael Pandolph.

He said he would like the Borough Manager to place this item on the September agenda.

**SEWER COMPLAINTS:** Councillor Hinkle said he has received complaints from residents on South Main Street about sewer going into their basements.

President Brumagin said this issue has been addressed at the Water Authority meeting.

**CATCH BASINS:** Councillor Steadman said the streets department has been cleaning out the catch basins. He said many of these catch basins that Paul Maynard has come across, has not been cleaned out in years.

**PLEASANT STREET:** Councillor Steadman said the supplies have been ordered for the bridge project on Pleasant Street.

**HOGAN ALLEY PARKING LOT:** President Brumagin said he noticed behind

Lafferty's building in the Hogan Alley Parking Lot, there is a catch basin that is completely full. He said he did speak with Paul this morning to let him know about it.

**SPECIAL MEETING:** The Borough Manager said she just wants to remind Borough Council that a Special Meeting to approve paving bids is scheduled for Monday, August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2009 at 7:00 P.M. at the City Building.
