

**MINUTES**  
**UNION CITY BOROUGH WORK SESSION**  
**APRIL 26<sup>TH</sup>, 2011**

The Work Session of the Union City Borough Council was called to order at 7:10 P.M. by President Brumagin. The meeting was held at the City Building.

She said Taryn would like to hold a teleconference with a member of Borough Council on Friday, April 29<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 A.m. to discuss the progress of the plan.

**MUSEUM:** Councillor McCrillis said that he had a chance to check on the water problem at the Museum. He said this issue needs to be taken care of as soon as possible. He said he would like the Street Supervisor to provide Borough Council with a cost on the materials that will be needed to repair the water problem at the Museum.

**BOROUGH DRIVE AROUND:** Councillor Bowes said he wants to remind everyone about the drive around scheduled for Saturday, April 30<sup>th</sup> at noon.

**MANGEL'S GAS STATION ON NORTH MAIN STREET:** President Brumagin said he received a phone call from Don Mangel. He said Don informed him that the deal with Tops to sell his building has fallen through. He said that Don is wondering if the Union City Municipal Authority and Borough Council would be interested in buying his building.

President Brumagin said if Borough Council is interested, he said he can call Don to see about touring the building.

Councillor Bowes said the Borough is not financially able to consider purchasing this building at this time.

**STREET SWEEPER:** Councillor Steadman said the street sweeper is back from getting fix.

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL ORDINANCE:** President Brumagin said he would like the Intergovernmental Ordinance be placed on the May agenda.
