

**MINUTES**  
**UNION CITY BOROUGH COUNCIL WORK SESSION**  
**SEPTEMBER 27<sup>TH</sup>, 2011**

The Union City Borough Council Work Session was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by President Brumagin at 7:00 P.M. at the City Building.

Councillors present were Brumagin, Bowes, Hoban, Kolaja, McCrillis and Steadman.

**PARKING IN FRONT OF THE CONGDON HOTEL:** Councillor Hoban said as much as he would like to see parking in front of the Congdon Hotel, he just does not see how it is going to work.

He said he went down there to take a look at the traffic flow and he could not see how parking would be possible in front of the Congdon Hotel.

President Brumagin said there might be a way to provide parking by cutting into the sidewalk between the bank and the Family Support Center.

Councillor Hoban said if this could be done, he would suggest that it be handicap parking.

He said if it would come up for a vote this evening, he would have to vote no.

Street Supervisor Paul Maynard said, he can talk with the people who are doing the handicap sidewalks in the Borough to see if they can provide the Borough with some handicap guidelines.

Debra Lyons said she does not care that the parking will be for handicap, she just would like to see some parking made available.

She said she would like to thank Borough Council for removing the sign in front of her building and for concreting the sidewalk.

**UNION CITY WATER AUTHORITY BOARD:** President Brumagin said Council needs to think about who to appoint to the Water Authority Board.

**PUBLIC WORKS:** Councillor Steadman said the street sign poles and the fire hydrants that were painted, look very nice.

He said the Streets Department will be grading the roads one more time before winter.

**HOMECOMING PARADE:** Councillor Bowes said that he and a few other members of Borough Council rode in the Parade. He said we had a great time.

**CODE ENFORCEMENT:** Councillor Bowes asked the Borough Manager “did you take care of the Code Enforcement issue?”

The Borough Manager said yes she did take care of the Code Enforcement issue.

**BOROUGH ALLEYWAY:** Debra Lyons said since the alleyway is owned by the Borough, she would like the streets department to take of the alleyway this winter.
