

MINUTES
UNION CITY BOROUGH WORK SESSION
AUGUST 21ST, 2007

The Work Session of the Union City Borough Council was called to order at 7:05 P.M. by President Brumagin. The meeting was held at the City Building.

Councillors present were Brumagin, Balog, Bowes, Buell and Tubbs.

POLICE VEHICLE: Councillor Tubbs asked if I have heard when the new police vehicle will be delivered?

The Borough Manager said as of this date, she has not heard anything.

Councillor Balog said he would like to see me go out for bid on the lettering of the Police cruiser.

The Borough Manager said she has never gone out for bid, because the amount is less than \$4000.00. She said the last time it was done, she was sure the cost was around \$250.00.

Councillor Balog said there is a local vendor in town that the Borough should check with.

CIVIL SERVICE: Councillor Tubbs said he would like to make sure that all members of Borough Council get a copy of the information that was sent to him by Attorney Rudolph.

The Borough Manager said she will make sure that all members of Borough Council receives the information.

RESOURCE OFFICER: Councillor Tubbs said he would also like to appoint a temporary Resource Officer. He said he would like this to be done at the Special Meeting that is scheduled for August 30th.

WINTER ROAD MAINTENANCE TRAINING: President Brumagin said he received information regarding training on “how to develop and implement a snow plan for your community.” He said the cost is \$25.00 per person. He said the closest training site is in Clarion. He said he would like to see the Streets Department attend this training.

Councillor Balog said he might be interested in going to this training.

INTERNATIONAL PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE: President Brumagin said Borough Council needs to decide on what they want to do about the information that was provided to us on the International Property Maintenance Code.

He said this is an issue that we need to talk about.

PEDDLING PERMIT FEES: Councillor Bowes said he would also like to see the Resolution to approve the peddling permit fees be placed on the August 30th agenda.
